



WHITE PERENDALE SLIVER

100% Pure New Zealand Wool

Perfect for all your fibre crafts.
Spinning, weaving, knitting, needle and wet felting.

The Perendale was bred in New Zealand by Professor Peren from selected Romney and Cheviot stock. It has high bulk with exceptional spring and resilience, so knitted garments are warmer and keep their shape. The wool is comparatively fine.

We have chosen the best fleeces from local farmers specialising in the Perendale breed to make our sliver. We select fleeces with well formed, open staples and defined crimp.

This crimp is retained when spun trapping air and providing wonderful insulation. Garments are also better able to spring back into shape after washing and wearing.

Ashford Perendale Sliver

Fibre diameter 30-34 micron
Staple length 12.5-15cm (5-6ins)
High Bulk

Suggestions for spinning

Spin into a medium semi-worsted or woollen yarn with approx 6 twists per 2.5cm (1in) in a plied, washed yarn.

Suggested uses

Knitting: Excellent for jerseys and blankets.
Weaving: Excellent for weaving blankets as the yarn is springy and soft.
Felting: Good for both wet and needle felting.
